- 5. Does the ministry include responsible participation in the deliberations and work of the presbytery and in the worship and service of a congregation? (G-11.0403e)

## If not validated ministry, what are the other options?

If one or more of the criteria cannot be met, the continuing member should ask to be designated member at large (G-11.0406b) or an inactive member (G-11.0406c) of presbytery. If presbytery is unwilling to grant this, then the continuing member should seek release from the exercise of ordained office until he or she receives a call to ministry that fulfills all five criteria (G-11.0414). Restoration to the exercise of office is possible without re-ordination by

- application and approval of the presbytery that granted release
- reaffirmation of ordination vows
- resumption of a ministry that qualifies for continuing active membership in presbytery
