#### NEW THIS WEEK

Reflection from Executive Presbyter, Wendy Tajima: <u>**Rest**</u>

Last week, LA County held a telebriefing to clarify that churches are still to hold online services only. The County is following State health orders, which holds in-person worship services under "Stage 3." There is no time frame for when Stage 3 begins. When the State does allow in-person worship, specific requirements will be announced, probably including:

occupancy kept to 25-50%

 $\cdot\,$  easy access to hand sanitizer or hand-washing stations

 $\cdot \,$  masks available if anyone arrives without one

- proper physical distancing
- regular cleaning of common areas

 proper signage instructing people of the requirements

 registration of all attendees, to aid in contact tracing if needed.
Strict limitations on funerals and weddings—and all private and public gatherings, inside or outside—are still in force until Stage 3.

<u>Great Plates Delivered</u> is a free service for LA County residents, providing up to three meals a day. The program is running now through June 10, 2020, though the state hopes to extend it. County

Mobile testing sites have been established for anyone who wants to get a COVID-19 test. There are sites at the Rose Bowl, El Monte Airport, and Pomona Fairplex. While they are prioritizing people with symptoms or exposure, essential workers, people who are over 65 or with chronic residents 65 or older, or 60-64 and at high risk as defined by the CDC, are eligible, regardless of immigration/citizenship status.
