Reflection from Executive Presbyter Rev. Wendy Tajima: Speaking and Loving

GA224 is history. Go <u>here</u> for a series of news articles from Presbyterian News Service.

LA County updated their Frequently-Asked Questions about Coronavirus. A few reminders from this document (by question number):

- 12. You should not have visitors, other than people who need to provide essential services, such as caregiving or repairs.
- 18. Childcare facilities can be open, as long as they follow requirements that are described in the Order.
- 21. [Children] can attend day camps (including sports-related camps for skills-building only), although overnight camps aren't open yet.
- 35. Individual and family gatherings or parties of any size aren't allowed. However, vehicle (car) parades are now . . . See the <u>Vehicle-Based Parade Protocol</u> for rules and requirements.
- 37. [M]ost face-to-face visits are still not allowed at . . . residential care facilities and at some hospitals, except for in certain circumstances (visiting a child and for end-of-life visits). However . . . some are now allowing visitors. If your loved one is in a facility, ask if they're allowing visits.
