#### **OPENING WORSHIP**

The Presbytery entered a time of worship facilitated by TE Jennifer Ackerman and led by members of the Presbytery using *The Litany of Light* resource. An *In Memoriam* video remembering members of the Presbytery, friends of the Presbytery, and members of our congregations who passed away since the November 2019 meeting.

#### **EXECUTIVE COMMISSION**

TE Cyndie Crowell reported for the Commission.

#### ACTION TAKEN ON BEHALF OF THE PRESBYTERY

- 1. Concurred with the Commission on Ministry to commit \$24,000 in first-year funding for a new worshiping community in Rowland Heights, led by Sam Bang, and to request that Synod of Southern California and Hawaii match the grant with \$24,000 from San Gabriel's allocation in the Partnership Grants Fund. [The Synod approved the grant request.] For now the ministry will be called Rowland Heights Presbyterian Fellowship.
- 2. Voted to extend the suspension of the bylaws (that temporarily distributed duties assigned to the Vision Strategy Team to other bodies) up to one more year. The Presbytery voted on this suspension in November 2019, but since this year was so unusual it was determined that another year would be needed to see if the current interim structure is preferable. This action will keep the VST vacant through 2021, unless a bylaws change is adopted during the year.
- 3. Voted to hold both January 26 and March 20, 2021, Presbytery meetings via Zoom.

#### FOR INFORMATION

- 1. Reviewed and gave feedback on the preliminary draft of the 2021 budget, and referred it back to the Administration and Finance Committee to finalize it and present to the Presbytery.
- 2. Reviewed and gave feedback on the Personnel Committee's proposed change to the Stated Clerk position.

Cyndie introduced Sam Bang who will be the leader of the Rowland Heights Presbyterian Fellowship. Sam shared about his hopes for this development and the challenges of a new church development during a pandemic. Sam expressed his thankfulness to the Presbytery for the warm welcome and show of support.

#### **COMMISSION ON MINISTRY**

TE Cyndie Crowell reported for the Commission.

#### The Presbytery M/S/V to approve the following items in an Omnibus motion:

1. To receive the resignation of TE Bear Ride (HR) and to elect RE Tom McGuinness (Knox) to the Baldwin Park Administrative Commission.

2. To renew the call of TE Steven Wiebe as Executive Pastor with Pasadena Presbyterian Church, effective September 16, 2020, for a designated term of 2 years with the following terms of call:

Salary and Housing \$67,500
Pension 24,975
Professional Expenses 2,735

Continuing Education Reimbursement 1,020 (two weeks)

Vacation - one month

3. To extend the term of the Class of 2020 Session and Deacons at San Marino Community Church

and Good Shepherd Taiwanese Presbyterian Church, Monterey Park, for a period of one year.

TE Cyndie Crowell and TE Wendy Tajima explained how the New Form of Government described how an Associate Pastor may become the installed Pastor or Co-Pastor of the same congregation. They also described how TE Jessica Vaughan Lower's work as an Associate and vision for the future of the congregation fits with the mission plan for SMCC. They explained the process that SMCC used in communication with the congregation and the results of the Congregational Meeting. Rev. Jeff O'Grady also shared his perspective.

**The Presbytery M/S/V** to approve the call of TE Jessica Vaughan Lower as Co-Pastor/Co-Head of Staff of San Marino Community Church, effective October 4, 2020, for a designated term of one year, and to change the call of TE Jeff O'Grady to be Co-Pastor/Co-Head of Staff of San Marino Community Church, at his current level of compensation.

Background: According to G-20504C, "A presbytery may determine that its mission strategy permits a minister of the Word and Sacrament currently called as an Associate Pastor to be eligible to serve as the next installed pastor or co-pastor, or a minister of the Word and Sacrament employed in a temporary pastoral relationship to be eligible to serve as the next installed pastor, co-pastor, or associate pastor. Presbyteries that permit this eligibility shall establish such relationships only by a three-fourths vote of the members of presbytery present and voting." The Session of San Marino Community Church consulted extensively with the COM in taking this course of action upon hearing of Rev. O'Grady's intention to retire in 2021. After thorough consideration and consultation with each pastor of SMCC and two town halls with the congregation, the COM determined that at this time in the life of SMCC, and given the prior and current leadership experience of Rev. Vaughan Lower, along with the unique constraints of the COVID pandemic, this action is appropriate to the church's current situation and missional strategy.

work as Co-Pastors and as they lead the San Marino Community Church through TE Jeff O'Grady's retirement after 15 years of ministry.

#### **COMMISSION ON PREPARATION FOR MINISTRY**

TE Jan Cook reported for the Commission.

TE Jan Cook shared that the Commission on Preparation for Ministry has put together an Intern Guidelines Policy thanks to the work of Commission member TE Mary Ellen Azada and TE Lisa Lamb. She encouraged pastors to familiarize themselves with the policy in order to help inquirers and candidates in their community plan their internship. See Appendix E

Jan introduced prospective inquirer, Ashley Roque of Calvary Presbyterian Church, South Pasadena. Ashley shared about her call to ministry and her hopes for the future in ordered ministry.

#### **ACTION**

**The Presbytery M/S/V** to enroll Ashley Roque as an Inquirer.

Jan offered a prayer for Ashley after she was enrolled as an Inquirer.

#### PERSONNEL COMMITTEE

RE Carl Von Bibra reported for the Committee.

RE Carl Von Bibra shared that upon hearing of Twila French's retirement at the end of November, and in anticipation that the terms of both the Stated Clerk and Executive Presbyter end in May 2021, the Personnel Committee met with several staff members about their personal plans, and suggestions on ways the staff can be more effective. Based on their feedback, the Personnel Committee is proposing changing the structure of the stated clerk responsibilities in 2021 to the following:

- 1. Stated Clerk for Judicial Process Fulfills the Stated Clerk's role in the judicial process for the Presbytery as outlined in the Rules of Discipline. The Stated Clerk for Judicial Process will work on an on-call basis and paid on an hourly basis. See attached job description. See Appendix F
- 2. Stated Clerk for Administration All non-judicial responsibilities of the Stated Clerk as outlined in the Book of Order. The Stated Clerk for Administration is a half-time exempt position, with other administrative responsibilities for the Presbytery. See attached job description. See Appendix F

The current Stated Clerk, TE Diane Frasher, chose not to accept another three-year term as Stated Clerk for Judicial Process. To facilitate the transition, she is ending her work as Stated Clerk effective March 1, 2021. TE Ally Lee, currently Presbyter for Administration and Associate Stated Clerk, has been offered the position of Stated Clerk for Administration, and will be presented for election by the Presbytery at the March 2021 Presbytery meeting. If this new structure is approved by the Presbytery, the 2021 budget will reflect this new structure, and we will begin searching for the Stated Clerk for Judicial Process, for election in March 2021.

#### **ACTION**

The Presbytery M/S/V to approve a new structure of stated clerk duties, effective March 1, 2021.

#### FOR INFORMATION

- 1. As previously announced, Twila French will go from part-time bookkeeper to fully retired on December 1, 2020. She will be greatly missed. During the meeting TE Stephanie Kang led a time of reflection with remembrances of Twila shared by Wendy Gist, Mark Carlson, Diane Frasher, Bob Wendel and Wendy Tajima. The Presbytery gifted Twila an engraved vase celebrating her 19 years of service and a gift card to Amazon. Twila shared her own remembrances and gave thanks to the Presbytery for many years of joyful ministry together.
- 2. The Presbytery has contracted with Keith and Zulima Clark-Hoyos to provide bookkeeping and payroll services effective November 1, 2020. Keith and Twila are working to create as seamless a transition as possible. Keith and Zulima were introduced to the Presbytery.
- 3. Thanks to renewed funding from Presbyterian Disaster Assistance, Synod of Southern California and Hawaii, Claremont Presbyterian Church, and other churches and individuals, Kristi Van Nostran has moved to full-time status in her role as Immigrant Accompaniment Organizer. She now works with Presbytery of Riverside and Presbytery of San Gabriel.
- 4. We give thanks for Stated Clerk Diane Frasher, her integrity and commitment to San Gabriel Presbytery, and her many gifts in ministry. While she will leave the Stated Clerk position, the Personnel Committee is very happy that, assuming we receive another grant from House of Rest, she will continue as Chaplain for Retired Presbyterian Church Workers at Monte Vista Grove Homes.

#### ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE COMMITTEE

TE Steve Wiebe reported on behalf of the Committee.

San Gabriel Presbytery appointed a Budget Task Force for 2021 comprised of representatives from Administration and Finance, Personnel, and COM, with staff support from the Bookkeeper and Executive Presbyter. A preliminary draft budget was reviewed by the Presbytery Executive Commission on October 13, 2020. The budget was further refined and approved for recommendation to the Presbytery by the Administration and Finance Committee on October 21, 2020, with a quorum present, and recommends the attached budget to the Presbytery. For more details on the budget proposal and the final budget see Appendix G

In response to the continued uncertainty for the member congregations, the Administration and Finance Committee recommended reducing the per-member apportionment to \$58 with the request that churches who can give more continue to give as they are able.

#### **EXECUTIVE PRESBYTER'S REPORT**

TE Wendy Tajima gave her report on the state of the Presbytery.

She reflected on the work of the Presbytery in 2020 and how despite the disruptions of the pandemic the Presbytery has been engaged in its mission.

- During the January Presbytery Meeting, the Presbytery approved changes to the Pastor Compensation Policy establishing a family-friendly leave policy including paternal leave and family care leave. At the January meeting the process for Alhambra True Light's dismissal was finalized. The funds from that agreement allowed for the Presbytery to offer rental relief and contribute to technology grants for our member congregations.
- The Presbytery with matching funds from the Synod was able to give almost \$300,000 in grants to our member congregations for COVID-19 Relief.
- Presbyterian Disaster Relief gave \$10,000 in emergency grants to support settled refugees and immigrants in our churches. With the support of Pacific and Riverside Presbyteries, Immigrant Accompaniment Organizer, Kristi Van Nostran was able to support 100 people who were released from Adelanto find a place to stay and make their way to the sponsors.
- The West Covina Fellowship and Ministry Center has served to provide an area for the Fellowship to meet and to provide a ministry center that houses International Theological Seminary and hopefully future endeavors. This center has served as a model for the national church.
- We have found new ways to connect by designing online meetings for the Presbytery and for several congregations, we have interpreted ever-changing government regulations. We put together a shared worship service for World Communion Sunday and Winterfest 2021.
- Our chaplains for Retired Church Workers have used telephones and letters to stay connected with our members.
- Thanks to the legacy of First Presbyterian Church Baldwin Park, we hope to enable a housing development including a Presbytery house for supporting immigrant housing. Wendy Gist is providing staff support for this project.

#### **BOARD OF PENSIONS PRESENTATION**

TE Kristin Leucht, Church Consultant with the Board of Pensions, shared resources from BoP for the Presbytery.

The Employee Assistance Program offers Mental Health Resources for Medical Plan members and their households. They offer six free confidential sessions with a licensed clinician available twenty-four hours a day at (866) 640-2772. Retirees and Church Employees not enrolled in Medical Plan may utilize a toll-free help line staffed by licensed clinicians also available twenty-four hours a day at (866) 912-1687.





#### Presbytery of San Gabriel Report of the Presbytery Executive Commission

January 26, 2021

The San Gabriel Presbytery Executive Commission (PEC) met on December 8, 2020, and January 12, 2021, via Zoom video conferencing, with quora present, and makes the following report to the Presbytery. There are no recommendations for Presbytery action, but the PEC took several actions on behalf of the Presbytery.

#### ACTIONS TAKEN ON BEHALF OF THE PRESBYTERY

- 1. The Executive Commission discussed the lease agreement with International Theological Seminary, and the tentative agreement for an amendment to the agreement for January 1-June 30, 2021. The agreement would include amendments:
  - a. ITS' monthly payments would be increased from \$3,500 to \$5,000 (inclusive of the \$1,000/month added payments January-March for deferred payments from last summer).
  - b. The Presbytery and ITS will work together to bring additional tenants when LA County and Presbytery health orders permit.
  - c. Income from additional tenants would be used first to cover property expenses, and in the unlikely event that there is surplus income, it would be allocated primarily to ITS.
  - d. The Presbytery will continue to manage the property, including an on-site property manager, professional cleaning and landscaping services twice a month, showing and onboarding eligible tenants, and normal property repairs as needed.

The Executive Commission moved to affirm the amendment negotiated with ITS; however, ITS asked for reconsideration, so this action might need to be reconsidered.

2. The Executive Commission affirmed the officers of the Presbytery corporation, effective from January 2020 until replacements are elected. The current officers are:

TE Steve Wiebe, President TE Bill Van Loan, Secretary RE Freya Schmus, Treasurer.

3. In a called meeting on January 12, 2021, the Executive Commission discussed and approved a letter to all our churches, advising them to continue worshiping online and/or outdoors, including for Easter (see attached).

#### FOR INFORMATION

1. TE Jennifer Ackerman requested to be removed from the Administrative Commission for the West Covina Ministry Center, since she has moved to Portland, Oregon.

Dear Congregations of the San Gabriel Valley Presbytery,

Due to a recent Supreme Court case the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health has removed the prohibition of indoor worship. However, the current surge of COVID-19 infections makes indoor worship unsafe for our communities.

Therefore, the Executive Commission of the San Gabriel Presbytery strongly advises its congregations to follow the current guidance of the LACDPH regarding worshipping communities. This advice is currently summarized in Section 8t of the December 30 Health Order. We will continue to update this guidance in consultation with the county health department. At this time, we advise our congregations plan to celebrate Easter online or outside.

#### Highlighted Text:

#### t) Places of Worship.

Places of Worship should engage in outdoor or remote faith-based services and other related activities for all attendees, especially those who are vulnerable to COVID-19 including older adults and those with co-morbidities, given the increased risk of community transmission of COVID-19 resulting from the unprecedented surge of new daily cases, hospitalizations, and premature deaths, as well at the severely reduced Intensive Care Unit (ICU) bed capacity. When carrying out virtual activities indoors, it is recommended that no more than 10 individuals participate in production and broadcast process; anyone participating in production and broadcast must follow infection control and physical distancing requirements. The number of persons on site (indoors or outdoors) at any time shall be reduced as needed to permit compliance with physical distancing and infection control requirements, as specified in the Social (Physical) Distancing Protocol (Appendix A), including but not limited to Places of Worship staff and attendees at any faith-based services maintaining a minimum of six feet between attendees from different households and that all attendees must wear a face covering or mask over both the nose and mouth at all times while in attendance and when walking near or past non-household members, among others. If drive-in outdoor services are offered, cars are directed to park at least 6 feet apart. The California Department of Public Health advises that "activities such as singing, and chanting negate the risk-reduction achieved through six feet of physical distancing" due to an increased likelihood for transmission from contaminated exhaled droplets. Consider practicing these activities through alternative methods (such as internet streaming) that ensure individual

congregation members perform these activities separately in their own homes or alone in a separate room at the Place of Worship. Please review the State Industry Guidance for Places of Worship and Providers of Religious Services and Cultural Ceremonies here. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends organizations consider temporarily suspending singing, chanting, or shouting, especially when indoors. If attendees choose to sing, chant, or shout, encourage them to continue wearing their masks while doing so and increase the distance between people to greater than 6 feet. The protocols set forth in Appendix A and in this paragraph 8(t) do not obligate and should not be read to, in any way, encourage Places of Worship to resume any in-person activity.

The Executive Commission will continue to follow the updates to LACDPH's guidance for places of worship and will update our congregations with new information as it becomes available.

#### Personnel Committee Report Presbytery of San Gabriel January 26, 2021

- **1. Thanks to the continuing support of the House of Rest Board**, Lauren Evans and Diane Frasher are continuing as **Chaplains for Retired Presbyterian Church Workers**. Diane will increase her hours from 17 hours to half-time effective March 1, 2021, which is the beginning of the grant year.
- **2.** Diane Frasher is leaving her position as **Stated Clerk** effective February 28, 2021. As approved in the Presbytery meeting on November 16, 2020, **the role of Stated Clerk will be filled by two different positions**:

The position for **Stated Clerk for Judicial Process** is open for consideration; anyone who is interested in the position can still apply until the end of January. Since we do not currently have a candidate, the PEC will act on a replacement for March, per the Presbytery bylaws.

As reported in November, the Personnel Committee recommends that the position for **Stated Clerk for Administration** be filled by Ally Lee, effective March 1, 2021. The bylaws state that the Stated Clerk should be elected in May for a three-year term; however we do not have a Presbytery meeting scheduled for May in 2021. We will sort out how to handle the timing issue and present to the Presbytery meeting scheduled for March 20, 2021.

Action needed: The Personnel Committee recommends that Rev. Ally Lee be elected as Stated Clerk for Administration, effective March 1, 2021, on a temporary basis.

3. Again, we **thank Rev. Frasher for her faithful service**, and we are glad that she will continue her important work as chaplain with the Monte Vista Grove community.


