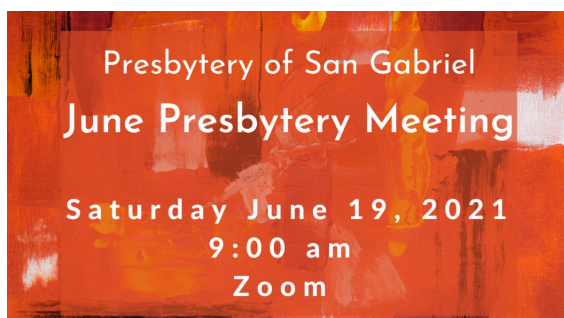
Delayed, Not Canceled

Update on Re-Opening:

On June 15, the State of California is rescinding most of the restrictions put in place to prevent spreading of COVID-19. There will continue to be mask requirements, including Cal/OSHA mandates that all employees wear masks unless they know that every person they encounter have been vaccinated, and all people should wear masks while on public transportation, and indoors at youth-oriented settings, healthcare and long-term care facilities, and congregant living settings such as shelters, prisons, and detention centers. Also, all unvaccinated people are required in all indoor settings. See <https://www.cdph.ca.gov/Programs/CID/DCDC/Pages/COVID-19/guidance-for-face-coverings.aspx> for the revised order. LA County is expected to follow the State guidelines.
