#### The Opposite of Reparations

#### A Note on Re-Opening:

We anticipate that many changes will come into effect on June 15, but we have not received any definitive guidance yet. In a telebriefing last Friday, the L.A. County Health Officer seemed to say that he expects virtually all guidance (and restrictions) for churches to be removed on June 15, except he does not yet know about the continued use of masks, and there continue to be guidelines for activities with young people (preschools, schools, camps-these will apply to Sunday School and church camps). Cal-OSHA has, however, ruled that starting on June 15, all employees must continue to wear masks in their workplace unless every person they interact with are known to have been vaccinated.
