It is with a heavy heart that I share the
news that the 2022 Presbyterian Youth
Triennium has been cancelled. With so
many factors regarding COVID surges and
necessary protocols to keep all delegates
and staff safe, the national staff
determined that this event would pose too
much possibility for risk of exposure and
spreading of COVID. However, plans are
already underway for 2025 and
discovering creative ways God may be
calling young people to learn more about
the connectionalism of the church and
God's people.

Analise Brown, National Registrar, wrote in an email to all local delegation registrars, "This decision was made thoughtfully and prayerfully alongside our 2022 Coordinators, under the guidance of our COVID Medical Advisory Team, and with the support of Presbyterian Mission Agency leadership." So many people were holding our youth, young people, staff, and volunteers in their prayers while discerning this difficult decision. I too hold you in my prayers as this may be another reminder that we are not yet out of the pandemic and yet remain hopeful that God will help us discover new ways to stay connected.
