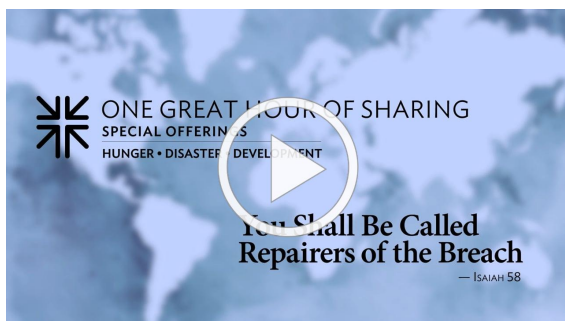

## **Pandemic Requiem Premieres in Claremont on April 10**

Geri DeMasi, Director of Music at  
Claremont Presbyterian Church, has  
composed a new choral work to mark the  
losses that have come to our community  
during the COVID-19 pandemic. Pandemic  
Requiem follows the traditional requiem  
form used by Verdi, Mozart, Britten, and  
other well known composers. Claremont  
Presbyterian Church invited DeMasi to  
compose the work as a way for our  
community to come together not only to  
mourn all that has passed since March  
2020, but also to look forward in hope.  
Composer DeMasi grew up in Claremont  
and is a graduate of both The Webb School  
and Pomona College.

The first performance of Pandemic Requiem  
will take place **Sunday, April 10 at 7:00  
PM** in the sanctuary of Claremont  
Presbyterian Church, 1111 N. Mountain
