It is likely that LA County will reinstate the indoor masking mandate this Thursday. The test positivity rate is 16% though doctors are reporting a positivity rate of 40%. (The positivity rate is higher because many people are testing at home and not reporting the results.) Whether or not the County mandates it, please consider recommitting to indoor masking, especially when singing, even when people are vaccinated. The current variant seems to be able to "evade" the current vaccines, though they still help reduce symptoms.
