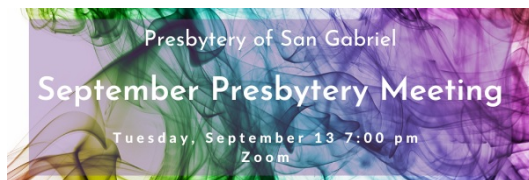

September 20-22

The Syria-Lebanon Partner Network of the PCUSA will hold its annual gathering at CPC September 20-22. The gathering will include presentations via ZOOM with ecumenical leaders from the region such as Rev. Najla Kassab, President of the World Communion of Reformed Churches (WCRC), Rev. Committee at Zephyr Point, Lake Tahoe. This event, which has been guided by our own Bryce Little, will have three extraordinary speakers: Rev. Dr. Liz Theoharis, former GA Co-Moderator Ruling Elder Elona Street-Stewart, and former GA Moderator Rev. Bruce Reyes-Chow.

This Consultation invites all people interested to join in celebrating our diversity and to hear from guest speakers who will challenge us to form the future witness of inclusion and witness for all God's people.

Bryce Little and Wendy Tajima are hoping to gather a contingent from San Gabriel Presbytery to attend. We will register as a group, and will coordinate transportation for those who are interested in going up to Lake Tahoe together.
