#### CPC Hosts Syria-Lebanon Partner Network Annual Gathering September 20-22

The Syria-Lebanon Partner Network of the PCUSA will hold its annual gathering at CPC September 20-22. The gathering will include presentations via ZOOM with ecumencial leaders from the region such as Rev. Najla Kassab, President of the World Communion of Reformed Churches (WCRC), Rev. Joseph Kassab, Secretary General of the National Evangelical Synod of Syria and Lebanon (NESSL), and Rev. Elmarie Parker, PCUSA Regional Liaison to Syria, Lebanon and Iraq. There will also be in person presentations from local Syrian refugee families. Other highlights will be panel discussions, small group conversations, worship, and a wonderful middle eastern meal on Wednesday evening.

This is a great opportunity to learn more about the PCUSA's ongoing partnership with churches from Syria and Lebanon and meet other Presbyterians involved with this work.
