Job Title: ELM/SLM Youth Ministry Intern

Job Purpose: Provide leadership and direction for PPC's English and Spanish Language education for youth grades 7-12 (Middle School and High School).

Reporting Relationship: ELM/SLM Children and Youth Coordinator and Senior Pastor

Day-to-Day working relationships ELM/SLM/ Children and Youth Coordinator and Senior Pastor, Staff, and Volunteers

Directly Supervises: ELM/SLM volunteers in the Middle School and High School Church School programs

Employment Status: Part-Time (estimate 10-15 hours/week)

FLSA Status: Exempt

Compensation: \$500/Month

Job Responsibilities:

1. Lead with volunteers all middle school and high school activities,
2. Recruit and train volunteers for youth education and programs.
3. Assist as needed in curriculum choice with the ELM/SLM Children and Youth Coordinator
4. Encourage parents and youth to participate in worship and the education program and build relationships with youth and their parents.
5. Attend and occasionally participate in Sunday morning worship ELM and SLM to provide continuity for youth.
6. Lead youth group in meaningful service and mission opportunities
7. Be present as appropriate in class offerings on Sunday
8. Prepare and lead Youth programs (Sunday or Wednesday)
9. Help youth prepare and participate in an annual Youth Sunday worship service in the spring.
