### **CALL TO ACTION - SB 4**

As many of you know, affordable housing advocates and organizations in California have been working to get church land rezoned for affordable housing for several years. There has been modest success at the local level in Pasadena, and now we are on the verge of getting a bill passed at the state level that will rezone religious and college land across California.

Senate Bill 4 (SB 4) has already passed the CA Senate. It is now in the CA Assembly and moving through its final committee (Appropriations) before it will move to the Assembly floor for a final vote. So, this is the time to act!

Please call or write your CA Assembly Member and urge him/her to vote in favor of SB 4. This is the time to do it!
