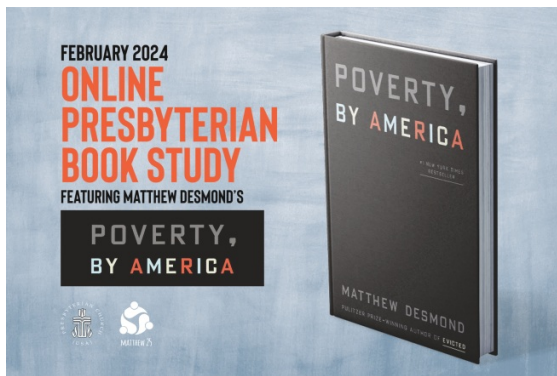



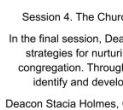
Session 1 - The Church and Community Involvement (Feb 7)
